The Department of Psychology, Mount Carmel College in association with PARIVARTHAN Counselling Training and Research Centre are offering a PG diploma (104 hours) in '**Counselling Skills for Working with Children and Adolescents**'.

This course is aimed to bridge the gap between the theoretical know-how and the skills involved with effectively engaging with the target population of children and adolescents. Post-graduate Psychology students who are qualified to work at counselling & assessment centres, NGO's, schools and colleges will benefit from this certification.

The course offered is structured as follows:

**Introductory course: Self Awareness and Practical Skills (20 Hours)**

Tuesdays and Fridays, for a period of 2-3 weeks, from date of commencement between 9am and 1pm.

**Training Programme: Counselling Skills for Working with Children & Adolescents. (84 Hours)**

Every Tuesday, for a period of 12 weeks, from date of commencement between 9am and 4pm.

The training programme includes case discussions, assignments, presentations and supervised practicum. Personal counselling is mandatory and is the responsibility of the student.

**ELIGIBILITY:** Post-graduates in the field of Psychology.
